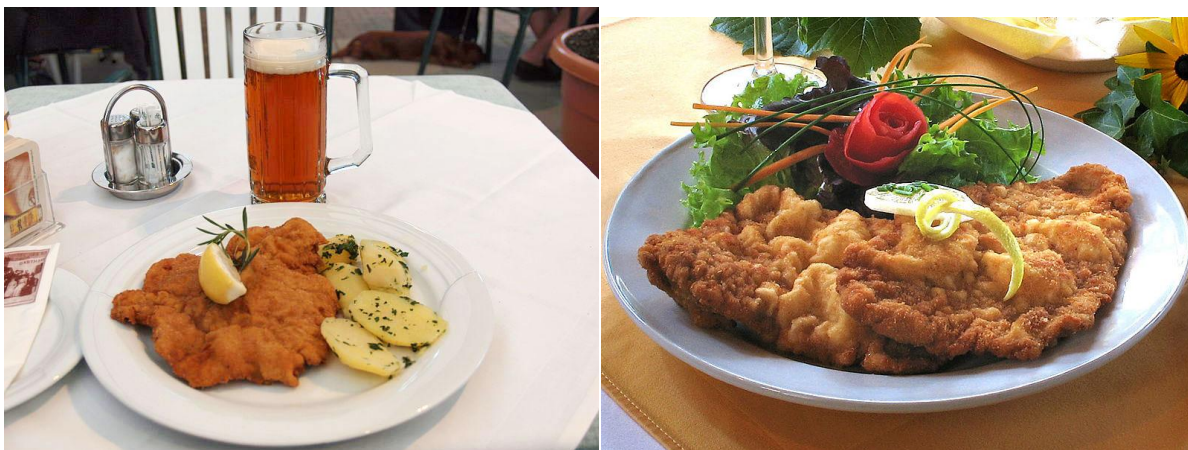

**Eurail Pass:**

The **Eurail** Group G.I.E. (sometimes referred to as **Eurorail**) is a [Netherlands](#)-based company, registered in [Luxembourg](#), that sells [passes](#) and [tickets](#) for European railroads. It is owned by a group of European rail carriers and shipping companies.

Its principal products are Eurail passes (formerly known as "Europass" and informally known as Eurorail Passes) and [InterRail](#) passes, with which a passenger has largely unlimited ability to travel on nearly all European railroads and some shipping lines at a fixed price per day of travel or travel within a certain number of days. Eurail sells a variety of passes, including those specific to two to five bordering countries, discounted passes for groups of up to five people travelling together, or for those under 26, passes which provide unlimited travel in a fixed period, and passes which provide a fixed number of days of travel in a longer period. InterRail passes are only available for European residents.

**BahnCard** (German *Bahn* – Rail) is a discount subscription programme offered by Deutsche Bahn (DB), the German national railway company. Unlike airline loyalty programs, but similarly to the UK Young Persons Railcard, the BahnCard entitles the passenger to a discount price and must be purchased prior to travel. Like most contracts in Germany, Bahncard contracts are **automatically renewed each year**, unless they are cancelled with sufficient notice. Three variants of Bahncard are sold by Deutsche Bahn: The BahnCard 25, the BahnCard 50, and the Mobility BahnCard 100. The first two variants allow passengers to get 25% and 50% discount respectively on standard **long distance** rail fares, while the Mobility BahnCard 100 is a type of annual ticket that allows free unlimited travel on most of the German railway network for a fixed price.

In 2007 there were 4.01 million BahnCard holders in Germany (~5% of Germany's population).<sup>[1]</sup> More than half of the passenger revenue of DB Fernverkehr (long-distance) comes from tickets sold to BahnCard holders.<sup>[1]</sup>
